Kamala School Lower Primary Years (P1 - P3) Update

This term, the **Primary 1** students explored number bonds with counting blocks; helping them to develop a strong grasp of number relationships and mental arithmetic. This hands-on approach encouraged active engagement, making abstract concepts more concrete and easier to understand, boosting confidence and problem-solving skills early on.



In **Primary 2**, it was wonderful to see students discovering their own learning strengths and using them to prepare confidently for their reading test. To make the test more engaging and to gauge their understanding, teachers randomly selected 10 words for each student to read. This approach encouraged students to be mindful of their own strategies and to build

confidence in their abilities. We have come a long way from the start of the term, to now see these young learners recognize what works best for them and take ownership of their learning journey.

Our **Primary 3** students had fun learning about the different places around us!

They practiced reading vocabulary, pronouncing words correctly and using the words in simple sentences. In addition to learning new vocabulary, the students also did a fun activity; the teacher wrote the words on the board in English and the students imagined each place and drew it on their papers. Then, they shared their drawings and talked about the places in their town.



Kamala School Upper Primary Years (P4 - P6) Update

Our **Primary 4** students embarked on a fun activity about School Subjects. Their teacher drew pictures representing each subject and wrote answer choices for the students to choose from. The students carefully looked at the pictures and circled the answers they thought were correct. The classroom was filled with laughter; friends helped each other and everyone was focused and determined.



Our **Primary 5** class, while learning about endangered, extinct and alive animals, discovered that an ostrich's stride can be a whopping 5 meters! They watched some cool videos to learn even more about these amazing birds. To understand how big 5 meters is, three of our students, who are about 1.5 meters tall, lay down head-to-toe. Many students already knew that ostriches live in Africa and eat plants and bugs.



We also talked about how some people think ostriches bury their heads in the sand, but that's not true!

In **Primary 6**, a class unit was all about exploring identity – personalities and talents – and understanding how each of us can be unique yet equal. After the exams, Teacher Jerlin conducted enrichment sessions on a related topic; the stages of human development, covering the physical, mental and emotional changes along with responsibilities such as self-care, maintaining healthy relationships, setting and respecting boundaries and understanding consent.



The Chicorée Foundation Kalim School PHBG TU Kindy Classes

Great Results

During the last Semester, the students learned vocabulary related to people in the school, shapes, face & body and animals. At the end of Term, the Kindy students were examined and assessed on various skills. The students did so well! Their overall average results were :

Kindergarten 1: **68%**

Kindergarten 2: **86%**

Kindergarten 3: **83%**



In Kindy 3, the top three students, with the highest results, received awards. This was done to recognize their achievement and to serve as motivation and encouragement for all students to continue improving themselves consistently.

In general, the students can now recognize and pronounce many letters correctly. They can also remember numbers, count objects and identify basic colours confidently.

New Term

This Semester, the students have made steady progress in all areas. They have shown improvement in classroom participation and social interaction, increased confidence in English language activities, demonstrated better social skills and stronger fine motor abilities. Great work students!

Lower Primary

The students did very well in their end of Term test in September 2025. Four grade 1 students, two grade 2 students and one grade 3 student obtained full marks. All the Primary classes achieved a higher overall average when compared to the last Semester (Term 2 2024-25).



Higher Primary

The students had good exam results at the end of Term, with three students sharing top place with full marks. After the test, the students undertook a post-term reflection where they evaluated what they did well last Term and what things they want to do better. They then shared their reflections and goals in front of the class.



New Term

In November the second Term started with the students in high spirits. They recalled the past lessons and new lessons were introduced. Our keen learners enjoyed playing classroom games, sang and danced to songs and played different characters from short stories. We have had an awesome start to the second Semester.
